

ETFO Halton - Master's Scholarship

The Master's Scholarship may be offered to active ETFO Halton Teacher Local members who are studying at the Master's level. Preference will be given to applicants studying in Education related areas or Labour Studies. Up to two recipients may each be granted a \$1,000 scholarship.

Criteria:

The Master's Scholarship may be granted to a current ETFO Halton member who:

- Is currently enrolled in a Master's program;
- Holds a valid Ontario College of Teacher's Certificate of Qualification;
- Has at least three years of teaching experience;
- Is a graduate of a recognized university;
- Is a member in good standing with the Elementary Teachers' Federation of Ontario;
- Has not previously received an ETFO Halton graduate level scholarship;
- Is currently employed by the Halton District School Board.

Procedures:

In order that the application be considered, please ensure that copies of the following are received by the closing date:

- Your letter of acceptance into the Master's program or your transcripts;
- A copy of your valid Ontario College of Teacher's Certificate of Qualification;
- Your completed application form;
- Your resume;
- An outline of your plan of study for your Master's Programme.

The application must be received by **April 19, 2024**, at the ETFO Halton Office via the board courier to the attention of the PA/PR Committee. The applications are processed by the PA/PR Committee.

Please note that materials submitted to the PA/PR Committee in support of an application become the property of the PA/PR Committee and will not be returned.
